### Program Fee

- Non-Partner University: \$ 1,100
- Partner University: 35% Off USD 700 (₩ 1,000,000)

- Airport transportation on arrival and departure days

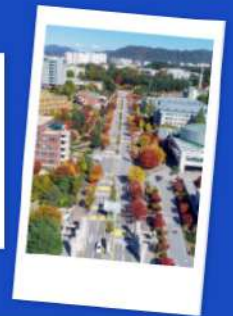

- Established in 1947, KNU is one of South Korea's 10 flagship national universities
- Accredited under the Korean Ministry of Education's EQAS (International Education Quality Assurance System)

- 18 colleges and 63 departments, 10 graduate schools and 55 research institutes
